HOW DO I APPLY?

To apply for the T-TEP, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be a current Honolulu Community College, Leeward Community College or Kaua'i Community College student pursuing an AS degree in Automotive Technology.
- You must have completed at least one semester in the Automotive Technology AS degree program and have at least one semester remaining in addition to the current semester before graduating.
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. (Cumulative GPA applies to all courses required in the AS Degree Program.)

If you meet the minimum qualifications, simply complete the T-TEP scholarship application form and submit it by the deadline stated on the T-TEP scholarship application.

The T-TEP began in 1992 in partnership with Honolulu Community College's Automotive Technology Program. The T-TEP program assists top candidates by offering scholarships and employment opportunities to selected students while earning their Associates Degree in Automotive Technology.

As a T-TEP Apprentice Technician, students will have the opportunity to apply newly learned skills from school on Toyota simulators and vehicles. T-TEP students will also have the opportunity to attend technical training seminars with full-time Toyota technicians, and gain Toyota Technician credits recognized by any Toyota Dealer.

To plan for a future in an constantly changing automotive industry, enroll in Honolulu Community College, Leeward Community College or Kaua'i Community College's Automotive Technology Associate Degree Program, in pursuit of scholarship and employment opportunities with Toyota offered through the T-TEP program.

HOW ARE THE RECIPIENTS SELECTED?

Applicants meeting the minimum requirements will take a written mechanical aptitude test. Based on the top test scores, finalists will be interviewed by the selection committee composed of representatives from Servco and either Honolulu Community College, Leeward Community College or Kaua'i Community College.

SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS WILL ALSO BE ASKED TO:

• Complete a Servco employment application (this is done on-line)

UPON RECEIVING A JOB OFFER FROM SERVCO, THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT WILL BE ASKED TO:

- Submit a current satisfactory traffic abstract.
- Successfully pass a drug test and physical examination.
- Successfully pass a criminal check.
- Successfully pass the education and employment verification process.
